Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan was founded in 1938 by Kulapati Dr.K.M.Munshi, as a symbol of intellectual, literary, educational, spiritual and cultural content of India flowing through the ages.

To preserve and propagate the great culture of ours, the Central Bhavan is fortified by three cultural centres - Bharatiya Kala Kendra devoted to the development of Indian dance, drama, music and other performing Arts; Bharatiya Sangeeth Shikshapeeth propagating Indian Classical Music and Dance and Bharatiya Nartan Shikshapeeth training students in Kathak and Bharatanatyam style of dancing.

To fulfill the noble objectives of the Bhavan, Shri G.K.Sundaram founded this Kendra in the year 1964. The Kendra runs three schools that impart value-based education and is rooted in Indian tradition and culture. Under the leadership of Dr. B.K.Krishnaraj Vanavarayar, who has been the Chairman of the institution since 1990, the Faculty of Fine Arts was established in the year 1996 to impart training in Indian Classical Art forms.

A Three Year Diploma Courses in Carnatic Music (Vocal), Veena, Mridangam and Bharatanatyam and a one year Certificate course in Devotional Music are being offered. The syllabus has been carefully framed to give the students a firm foundation in both theory and practical.

Students are promoted every year on the basis of their performance both in Theory and Practical examinations. On completion of the three year course, Bhavan awards Diploma Certificates. Bhavan's students have taken part in various music competitions conducted by different organisations and won prizes.
