

### The Recipients of the Awards

#### Shri V. Rajkumar Bharathi

Shri Rajkumar Bharathi was born in 1958 to Sri Venkata Subramanian and Smt. Lalitha Bharathi, the grand-daughter of Mahakavi Subramania Bharathi. She was the first Guru to introduce Rajkumar to the rich and long tradition of Tamil Music. He was then only five years old. Later he received training in Classical Music from experts like Valliyur Gurumurthi, Dr. M.Balamuralikrishna and Dr. T.V.Gopalakrishnan. In the course of time, he became a notable singer and composer. He is making real his great grand-father's dream, "தேமதுரத் தமிழோசை உலகெலாம் பரவும் வகை செய்தல் வேண்டும்" (we should try to spread the sweet nectar like Tamil Music all over the world).

After serving as an Engineer in R&D Department at Centre, he immersed himself in the service of music as a singer, composer, music director and coordinator for dance dramas. He is blessed with many awards in India and abroad.

### Shri N.V. Vaidyanathan

Shri N.V.Vaidyanathan was born in Nenmara, Kerala, in a traditional family of priests. After his education, he went to Mumbai to join a Pharmaceutical company. Then he learnt the basics of music from Panchapakesa Iyer of Bharathiya Fine Arts. Something - an intuition - illumined in his mind that he was born to devote his entire life to music. It was further motivated by Shri Balasubramanian, a great Pandit who taught him Thiruppugazh. Time passed and now he is known in and around Coimbatore as Thiruppugazh Vidwan.

Living in Coimbatore, nearby where Lord Muruga has His abode at Marudhamalai, Shri Vaidyanathan conducts regular Thiruppugazh classes. Hundreds of students follow him to learn and to spread Thiruppugazh's greatness. Online classes introduced him to all over the world. He always praises Guruji Delhi Raghavan who started Thiruppugazh movement for the spiritual upliftment of one and all.
